## who knows whose nose

### Setting up

Shuffle all the cards and place them face down in a pile. Take it in turns to take the cards from the pile until there are none left. Then put all of the noses into the grab bag and shake!!

### Game play

The youngest player starts. Players then take turns, moving from left to right. When your turn comes, reach into the grab bag and pull out a nose. If the nose matches one of your animals, fit it into the hole on that card. When all of the noses have been taken from the bag, the player with the most cards with the correct noses wins!

### Other suggestions for play:

#### Matching pairs

Lay cards out face down. Divide noses evenly among players. Players take turns turning over one card at a time. If the card turned over matches a nose, a pair is made and put to the side. If there is no match, card is put back and it is the next player's turn. The first player to match all of their noses with the correct cards, wins!

#### Guess who?

Pick a card from the pile but don't look at it. Hold it in front of your nose so everyone else can see it. Try to guess which animal you are by making an animal sound. The cow says "moo", the pig say "oink", the hippo says "hip-hip", the alligator says "chomp-chomp", the elephant says "toot-toot", and the bird says "chirp-chirp". If the sound you make matches the picture then you get the matching nose. Players alternate turns and the player with the most correct matches wins!

#### Fun to try:

Put the pig's nose on the alligator. What would you call this animal? What kind of sounds would it make? How many other funny combination of animals can you make?
