

Monster Modelling

Contents

Plastic Moulds, Paint, Brush, Modelling Material, instructions, Magnetic Strip.

Before you start

Find a clean dry working surface.

Make sure you have clean hands.

1. Take approx. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the modelling material from the packet.
2. Mould it between your hands by rolling it into a ball then pulling it out into a sausage shape. Roll it back into a ball. When you have done this several times the modelling material will be soft and spongy.

Place the ball of modelling material into one of the large shapes in your mould.

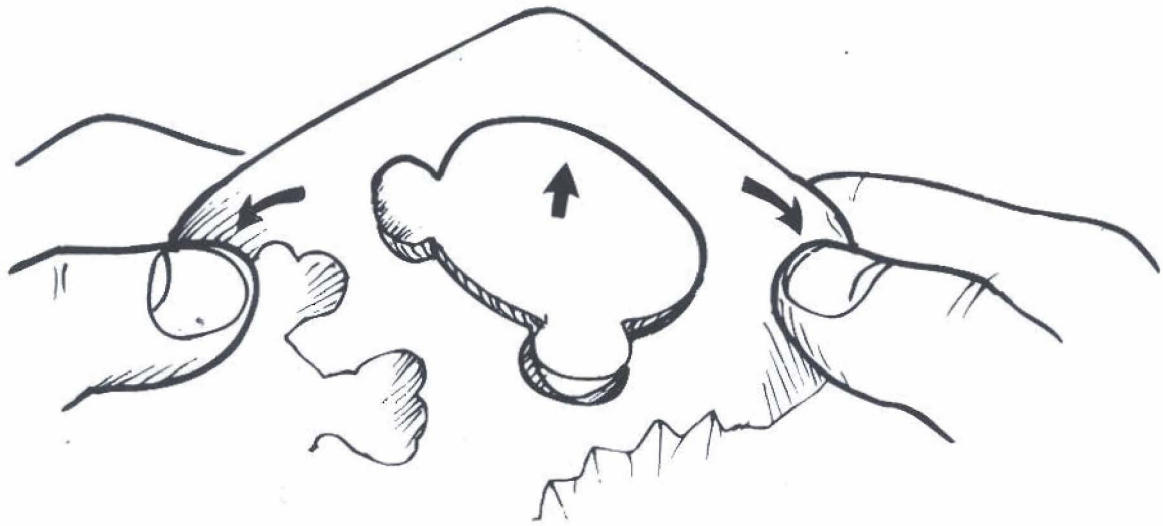
4. Press the ball down into the middle and pull it out to the top surface with your fingers.

The modelling material should be level with the mould surface. If there is too much, remove the modelling material, tear off a little piece and start again. The torn off piece can be used with your next shape.

If there is not enough for the mould, take it out, add a little more modelling material and reshape.



5. Turn the mould over onto a flat clean surface and press down firmly on the back of the mould. This will give a flat back to your finished shape.
6. Leave the mould to dry for 2 hours.
7. Carefully remove the Monsters from the moulds by pressing softly on the mould back.



8. Leave your moulds on a clean surface, right way up, to dry out for another 4 hours.
9. Cut the metallic strip into lengths of approximately 2cm.
10. Peel off the paper covering to reveal the sticky back and press the strips sticky side down firmly onto the middle of the back of the shapes.

Making more Shapes

Take another piece of modelling material the same size as before and use for another large character. Use smaller pieces for the smaller characters.

Painting your Fridge Magnets

All paints can stain. We suggest children wear overalls and/or old clothes and that you cover carpets and soft furnishings. Paint stains can usually be removed by cold soaking overnight, then washing with household soap and warm water.

You will need:

Pot of clean water, Kitchen towel, Clean white paper

1. Place the shape on the white paper.
2. Decide which colour to paint with first.
3. Clean your brush between colours with the water and dab dry with the paper towel.

ALLOW A COLOUR TO DRY BEFORE PAINTING ANOTHER. The paints are usually dry in approx. 5 minutes.

4. When all the colours are dry you can display your Monster on any magnetic surface.
