

Pop it in the Post!

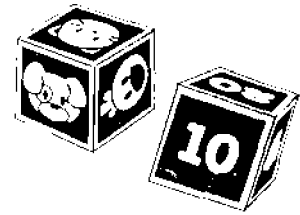


Age: from 1½ years

CONTENTS: 1 post box, 6 envelopes, 6 letters, 6 stamps, 2 dice (animal/number)

Getting Started

- Play pieces can be used at an early age for simple fitting. Fit a letter into an envelope and snap on a stamp.
- Use the post box and play pieces for fill and dump play.
- Talk to your child about the different colours used, the animals represented and have fun reading the letters together.
- Play simple matching games with the play pieces. They can be matched and sorted by colours, numbers, and animals.
- Post box and play pieces can be used as props in pretend play.



Posting Puzzles

- Solve each of the "puzzles" by matching an envelope, letter and stamp. Pass the completed "puzzles" out evenly among players. Take turns rolling the animal die only and posting the corresponding match.

Match and Mail

- Turn all the stamps and letters upside down. Play a memory game where you need to find a matching pair (letter & stamp) in order to get the envelope and then you can post!
OR
- Start with a specific envelope and try for your matching letter & stamp.

Posting Letters

- Each player chooses a letter to be posted. If 2 or 3 people are playing, each player may choose more than one letter. Players take turns rolling both the animal and number dice to obtain the envelope(s) and stamp(s) that match their letter(s). Once a player has received both a matching envelope and a matching stamp, that letter can be posted. The first player to post all of their letters, wins!
