PIGGY

PICK UP



GAME CONTENTS

1 Bouncing Piggy
9 Mudspot Targets (8 Pigsty Foodspots, 1 Soapyspot)

SETTING UP

Place Mudspots muddy side up on the floor.
Mudspots can be placed close together or far apart.

GAME IDEAS

PIGGY PICKUP!

Take turns rolling or bouncing Piggy over the Mudspots to pick them up.
As Piggy gets covered with Mudspots, he will roll in unpredictable ways!
Count how many rolls it takes to pick up all the Spots!

PIGGY POINTS!

Take turns rolling or bouncing Piggy to collect Mudspots.
If you get a Foodspot(s) stuck to the ball, remove it from Piggy's body and place it near you.
However, if you get the Soapyspot stuck to Piggy, return it and any other Spots that you have collected to the centre! The soap washes away your Mudspots!
When all the Foodspots have been collected, add up your points.
Note: Add up your points by counting the number of flies on the Food side of your Mudspots!
The player with the most points wins!

PIGGY PAIRS!

Take turns rolling or bouncing Piggy over the Mudspots to pick them up.
Each player gets two rolls or bounces to try to get a matching pair of Foodspots.
If you get a match, remove the Spots from Piggy and keep them near you.
If you do not get a match, return the Spots to the centre.
If you get the Soapyspot stuck to Piggy, you must return one of your matching pairs to the centre.
The player with the most matches when all the Foodspots have been collected wins!

PIGGY OUT!

Take turns rolling or bouncing Piggy to collect Mudspots. You may continue rolling as many times as you want, but be careful! Do not Piggy Out!
If you collect the Soapyspot, any Foodspots you have collected get washed off back to the centre!
When you decide to stop rolling, count up your points and announce your score.
Return Mudspots to the centre. Now it is the next player's turn to try to beat your score without Piggying Out!
