# Rhyming Lotto

36 amusing picture cards  
to be matched to a rhyming word  
on one of the 4 picture boards.

## HOW TO PLAY

This is a game for 2-4 players.

The game consists of 4 collecting boards and 36 picture cards. The object of the game is to be the first to cover the 9 pictures on your collecting board. A picture on the collecting board can only be covered by a word with which it rhymes eg. cat and mat, bananas and pyjamas, wall and fall (NB: adults may need to adjudicate). Each player is given a collecting board. Spare collecting boards may be distributed amongst the players or removed from the game. If removed, the matching picture cards may be left in the pack to make the game more difficult or removed before commencing.

### Game 1 Standard Lotto

Choose a game leader. Place the picture cards face down in a pile. The game leader turns up the top card and shows it to the players. If a player decides the card rhymes with a picture from their collecting board, they claim it and cover the matching picture. The game leader turns up the next picture card and the game continues until one player has covered all 9 pictures on their collecting board. This player is the winner.

### Game 2 Memory Lotto

Spread out the picture cards face down. The youngest player turns up a card in view of the other players. If it rhymes with a picture on their collecting board, they can place it on their collecting board and have another turn. If not, it is turned face down in the same place on the table. Play moves clockwise to the next player in turn. The player who needs the card should try and remember its position for when it is their turn. The first player to cover all 9 pictures correctly on their collecting board is the winner.
