

Shopping Game

This is a game for 2 to 4 players.

- The game consists of
- 1 playing board
 - 4 shopping trolleys (playing pieces) with stands
 - 16 grocery pieces (4 of each bread, cheese, apple, tin)
 - 15 red cards
 - 15 blue cards
 - 1 dice

The object of the game is to be the first to fill your 'home' trolley with one of each of the four different grocery pieces.

To Play

Place the grocery pieces on the correct positions in the various departments: cheese on the cheese counter, apple on the fruit counter, etc. Sort the blue and the red cards into two piles and place them face down by the side of the board.

Each player chooses a 'home' square, takes the appropriate coloured shopping trolley playing piece and places it on the start square.

The youngest player throws the dice first. The play then proceeds in a clockwise direction.

The players throw the dice to see how many squares to move around the board. A player landing on a white square with an apple on it, collects an apple from the fruit counter and places it on the correct shape in his/her 'home' trolley. Similarly, the cheese, tin and bread can be collected.

If the player lands on a black square with an apple on it, then the apple on his/her 'home' trolley (if he/she has one) is returned to the fruit counter. Likewise for the other grocery items.

No more than one item of each kind may be kept by any one player at a time.

More than one shopping trolley playing piece may occupy the same square at the same time.

Players landing on a blue or red square must take the top card from the appropriate pile of cards, carry out the instructions and return the card to the bottom of the pile.

Young players may play a simpler and quicker version of the game by ignoring the blue and the red squares and omitting the cards.
