

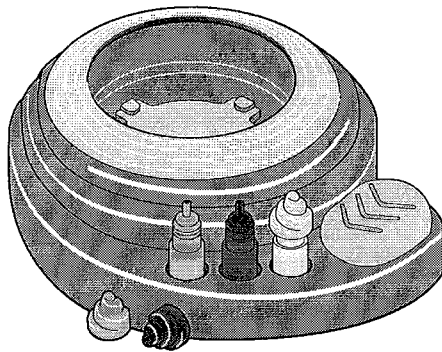

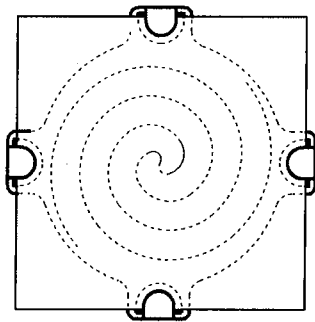
## Ideas for your twirl 'n' paint set

With your new twirl 'n' paint set you can create patterns and designs to decorate endless craft ideas. For all cutting activities we recommend the use of round ended safety scissors.

**Remember scissors can be a hazard to tiny fingers and adult supervision is recommended.**

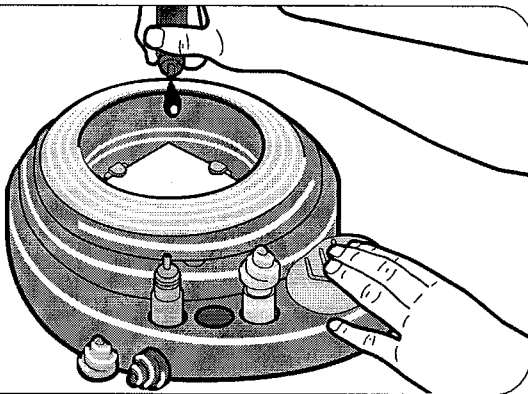
### play step

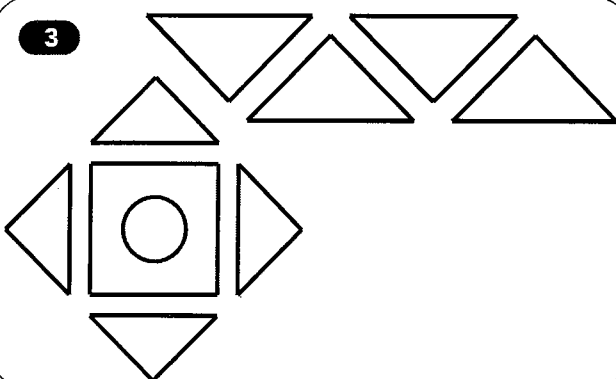
Remove the spiral rim and carefully place the paper square onto the spinner. Tuck the sides of the paper under the tabs as shown.

To operate, press the large button up and down repeatedly to spin the paper. Choose a colour, remove top and gently squeeze out drops of the paint onto the spinning paper. Add more colours for greater effects. To clean your Twirl 'n' Paint machine, please wash in warm soapy water. Here are just a few ideas for your painted squares....

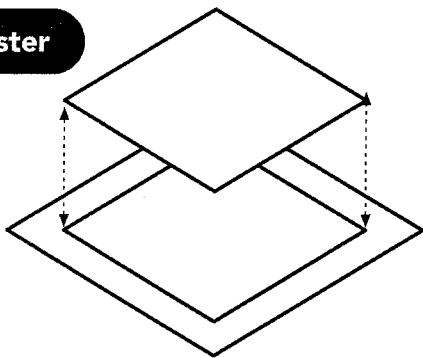

## Shapes and patterns

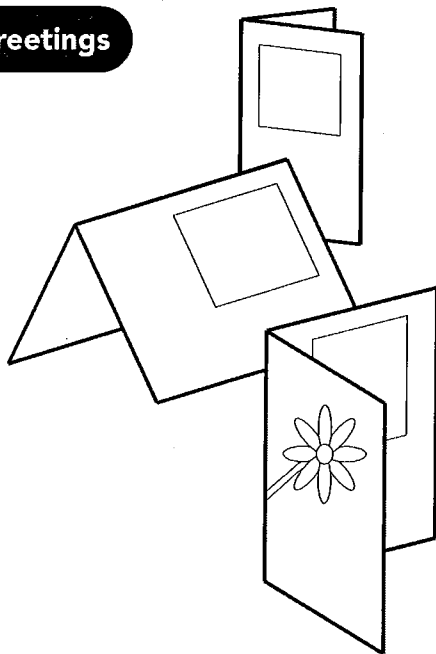
Cut up the square into different shapes. Re-arranging these shapes can create endless patterns.

### Coaster



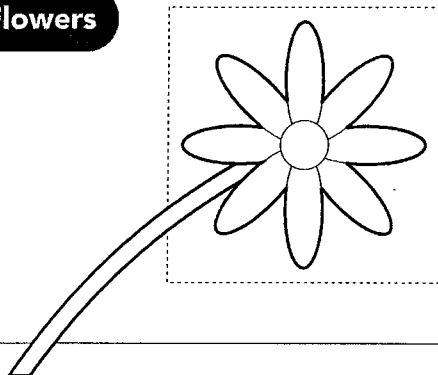
Cut a square of Early Learning Centre card slightly bigger than the painted square (to form a border). Glue the painted square onto the card and cover with see-through sticky backed plastic for a shiny and waterproof effect.

### Greetings



Fold a piece of plain card in half and decorate with the painted square. Cut into shapes and patterns and use with plain coloured paper to create individual cards. Glue the painted square inside the card and cut out patterns on the front for a different design. Make calendars in the same way.

### Flowers



Glue the painted squares onto thin card then cut out the shapes of the petals. Use a straw for a stem.

### Paint can stain

During all activities, we suggest children wear overalls and/or old clothes and that you cover soft furnishings and carpets.

Paint stains can usually be removed by cold soaking overnight, then washing with household soap and warm water. Gentle scrubbing can help.
