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how to play

getting started

- Play pieces can be used at an early age. Simply fit a letter into an envelope and snap on a stamp.
- Talk to your child about the different colours, the animals and have fun reading the letters together.
- Play simple matching games with the play pieces. They can be matched and sorted by colours, numbers, and animals.
- Post box and play pieces can be used as props in pretend play.

posting puzzles

Solve each of the “puzzles” by matching an envelope, letter and stamp. Put all the pieces together just like a puzzle, put the right letter in the right envelope, and post the finished letters in the post box.

match & mail

Turn all the stamps and letters upside down. Play a memory game where you need to find a matching pair (letters and stamps) in order to get the envelope and then post it in the letterbox. Or start with a specific envelope and try to find your matching letter and stamp.

posting letters

Play pretend and act out posting and delivering the letters. Help your toys post the letters, be the postman and take the letters out of the post box to deliver to all of the right toys. Open the letters, and help your toys to read the messages.
