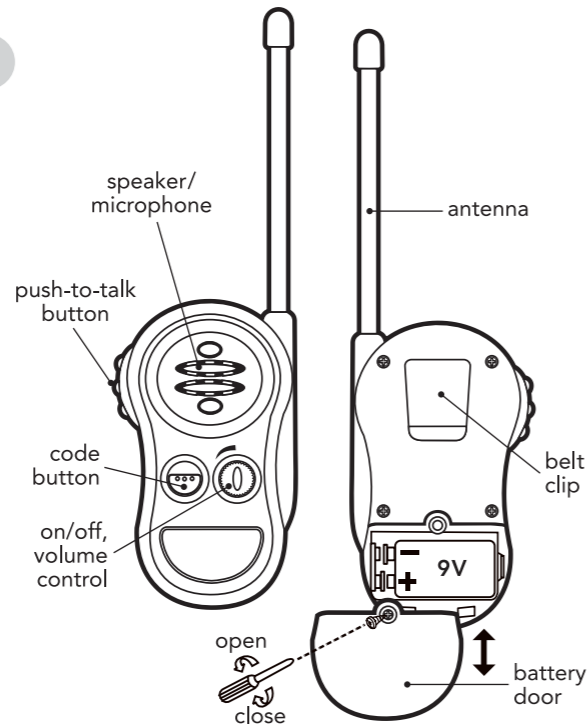
how to play

to transmit Morse code signals

1. Turn on the transceiver.
2. While holding the push-to-talk button, press the code button to transmit Morse code signals.
3. To receive signals, simply adjust the volume to a suitable listening level.

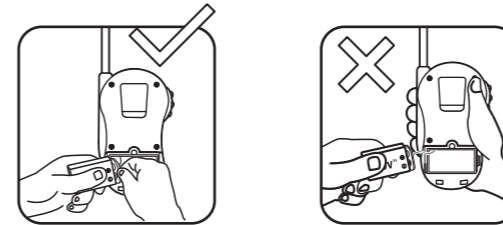
to operate the transceiver

1. Turn on the transceiver.
2. Press the 'push-to-talk' button to transmit signals.
3. Release the 'push-to-talk' button to receive signals.
4. When transmitting, speak clearly in a normal voice, and hold the set about 3 inches from your mouth.
5. Hold the transceiver in a vertical position to ensure ideal transmission and reception.




things need to care when using Walkie Talkie

1. Keep the product in a dry and clean place.
2. Don't touch the antenna with hands to avoid bad effect of receiving and transmitting.
3. Don't rotate the ON-OFF Volume control strongly when it's in ON or OFF position.
4. To avoid bad impinge on "PUSH-TO-TALK" button.
5. Don't disconnect the products randomly, no any non-professional adjustable parts inside the unit.
6. To avoid damage to parts inside of bad impinge on the product.
7. When the sound becomes weak or short distance, it is time to change the battery.
8. After use, always return the ON-OFF volume control to the OFF position to avoid the battery exhausted.
9. Please read operating instruction carefully and completely before using the product and keep the manual well after read it.



To avoid the damage to battery button, don't directly pull out the battery emphatically.
