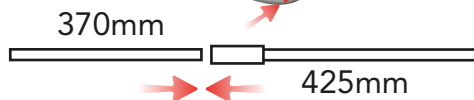
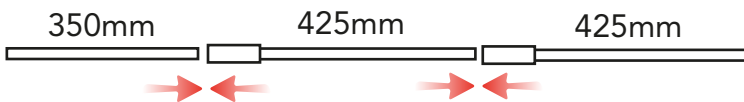


- Fold out (as shown).

WARNING!

- ⚠ This product has an internal spring frame that will 'pop' open with some force. NEVER let small children unfold or fold this product.
- ⚠ Never allow a naked flame near this product - although made from fire retardant fabric, it will burn if left in contact with a naked flame.
- ⚠ Clean only with a damp cloth - other cleaning substances might render the flame retardant coating ineffective.
- ⚠ Only use this product on level ground, clear of any stones or other sharp objects.
- ⚠ Designed for general child play - it is not waterproof or made for camping.
- ⚠ Do not continue to use this product if any part of the frame becomes either bent or broken, immediately contact Early Learning Centre in the event of a failure.

TIP

If the product refuses to "pop" back into shape: - follow the steel around the frame sleeve with your fingers, and "twist & flip" the steel band back around into alignment.

Fold Away

- Remove poles.

2



- Fold flat and hold as shown.

3



- Push downwards and let product curve outwards.

4



- Still pushing in, twist the right wrists inwards.

- Twist the left wrist inwards

- Fold the rest of the item down.

- Fold flat.

- Replace red warning band.
